# DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1, 05 Feb 24

Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel

Right after you go through immigration and customs one representative will meet you at **the Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) exit** to load the luggage into the vehicle and transfer you to the hotel. The hotel for tonight is close to **San Jose city**, located 25-15 minutes away from the airport. During the short drive, you will receive a **brief introduction to Costa Rica** and some recommendations for your trip. The guide will explain your itinerary in detail once you are in the hotel.



San Jose

Costa Rica's capital and the **largest city in the country**, San Jose is considered to be among the most cosmopolitan cities in Latin America. Downtown San Jose is the busiest part of town. A maze of streets and avenues, here you can find most of the city's museums as well as several hotels and plazas.

In the center of the city, several attractions can be found, such as the **National Theater**, **the National Museum**, **and the Jade Museum**. Also, several parks like **Plaza de La Cultura and Parque Morazan** are interesting places to visit. In San Jose exist a wide variety for gastronomic, each corner of the city has great restaurants or the famous **Barrio Escalante**, a gastronomic center where high-quality food is offered. But for more local and typical food the central market offers tasty food.

#### Day 2, 06 Feb 24



The Pacuare River, or the Río Pacuare, flows approximately 108 kilometers (67 mi) to the Caribbean. It is a popular location for **whitewater rafting**, whitewater kayaking, and river boarding. The **rainforests** that surround the river are home to exotic animal species such as **jaguars**, **monkeys**, **ocelots**, and a very large number of birds. Also, it was considered one of the **5 nicest rivers to practice rafting**.

### **3 Days in Pacuare Lodge**

Once you are ready to start the adventure, the expert guides will proceed with the safety talk, technical instructions, and you will have the chance to practice paddling on calm water. From there you will explore the stunning river rapids and enjoy the majestic scenery among you; today you will relish the river for about 1.5 hours until you reach the amazing Lodge immerged in the dense rainforest. A representative will pick you up early today and take you to the area of Siquirres on the Caribbean slopes. On the way, you will enjoy a delicious typical breakfast.

Upon arrival at the lodge, you can have lunch, the afternoon is free to rest on the comfortable suite, explore the hotel private trails or swim on the natural river pools.

#### Day 3, 07 Feb 24

This day you will enjoy the peaceful hotel in the middle of the forest. You can enjoy the facilities of the hotel and become one with nature.

The hotel has different activities included for you. You can get more information about these tours at the hotel. You can choose any of the following tours:

**Pacuare Canopy:** Most of the action in the rainforest happens not at ground level, but in the treetops. That's why the canopy adventure is perfect for thrill-seekers and nature lovers alike.

**Canyoning Tesorito Creek experience:** You'll rappel down shorter walls – between 2 and 20 meters (6 to 65 feet) – before undertaking the thrilling rappel down a 30-meter (90-foot) cliff.

**Cabecar Indigenous Hike:** The Talamanca Mountains are host to the Cabécar indigenous group and one that retains many of its traditional customs and beliefs. The trek to visit these family clans is challenging due to the difficult conditions of the trails; nevertheless, the trail offers a wonderful opportunity to discover many secrets of the forest.

**Early Birdwatching walk:** Costa Rica is a birder's paradise. Because of our position between North and South America, we receive migrating species from both sides of the continent. Costa Rica is home to some 850 species of birds, of which 630 are residents. There is ample opportunity to see exotic species every time you go out your front door.

**Rural experience:** Close to the Pacuare Lodge, on the far bank of the river, there is a small village called Bajo del Tigre Together with your naturalist guide, you will explore the river basin and rainforest by foot and visit the community of Bajo del Tigre, a small farming community that produces spices, roots, tubers, and more.

**Sustainable tour:** Experience a behind- the –scene tour of the hotel facilities. Learn more about the concept, history, and actions that have been taken to minimize impacts on the environment while supporting conservation and providing benefits for nearby communities.







#### Day 4, 08 Feb 24

Because there is not a better way to get out of this jungle paradise than riding a wild river for 2 hours, surrounded by magnificent scenery and accompanied by the best tour-guides who will make sure you have a lifetime experience in the Tropics.

This is without a doubt the most exciting activity you can do in the rainforest and takes place in one of the most beautiful rivers in the world. White water rafting in the Pacuare River will remind you the first time you ride a bike without help, or the first kiss... here you will forget about everything to focus on nature and enjoyment. Along the ride you will face exhilarating rapids that will keep you alert, some of these are Upper and Lower Huacas, Cimarron, and Dos Montañas. High waterfalls on the river banks make think this place came out from Jurassic Park or other Holywood movie, your mind flies while you paddle river down and try to stay in the raft. One half of the river is conquered, the guides will prepare a picnic lunch on the banks of the river; recharge energy with a delicious meal and enjoy the last part of this water adventure.

You will continue traveling to your next destinations.









Day 4, 08 Feb 24

Private Transfer from Guapiles to Arenal

La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers.** Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.

## Day 5, 09 Feb 24 Arenal Volcano Walking Tour

The trails in **Arenal National Park** and other nearby **Arenal Reserves** are generally flat and not very strenuous, perfect for a leisurely and informative guided walk with a professional nature guide. You will hike through well-groomed, **easy trails** that skirt the base of the Arenal Volcano and Lake Arenal Area. This part of the Arenal Volcano had sections that were devastated by **the lava flow of 1968**, so some areas have very little vegetation.

This guided walk provides **perfect photo opportunities** and **magnificent views** of the impressive Arenal Volcano, the pristine Lake Arenal and the extinct volcano Cerro Chato. There are parts of each trail that has forested areas where your nature guide will try to spot **birds**, **monkeys and other animals** in their natural habitat.



# Lake Arenal Kayaking

Bring your camera because this **2.5-hour paddle** across **Central America's secondlargest lake** gives you the best views of the behemoth Arenal Volcano and Costa Rican wildlife! Enjoy a pleasant time **kayaking on Lake Arenal** with breathtaking views of the **Arenal Volcano** and during your trip, you may observe different species of birds like the "Flycatcher," "Kingfisher," "Great Blue Heron" and "Anhinga" and may also possibly hear and see Howler monkeys up in **the rainforest trees** that surround the lake! **The view is spectacular** with the lake on one side of you, and the majestic Arenal Volcano and amazing lush rainforest on the other.

# Day 6, 10 Feb 24 Jungle Safari Float on Sarapiqui River / Lunch included

Come see the abundance of nature and wildlife that Costa Rica has to offer! This Costa Rica Safari Float is a smooth, two-hour paddle down the quiet, lower section of the Sarapiqui River and great for nature lovers of all ages especially children and their parents! Your bilingual nature guide will paddle and steer your boat as you float down the river and point out all of the exotic wildlife such as **birds**, **frogs**, **insects**, **and monkeys** in the Costa Rica rainforest!

Your eagle-eyed guide will show off Costa Rica's amazing wildlife as he points out a wide array of plant and animal species. You'll float next to the Mesoamerican Biological Corridor (San Juan La Selva Biological Corridor) where there is a good possibility of seeing **sloths**, **howler monkeys, lizards, and even black river otters.** 

For those who want to be even closer to nature, you will have the chance to get out of the raft and into the river and refresh yourself as we go down the river.

You'll rappel down huge waterfalls, jump into pools, zip down guided rappels, downclimb the canyon walls and river boulders, and hike up through the rainforest.

Start the rappelling-leg of your canyoning journey with the first waterfall referred to as the "Baby", a small-sized 10 feet waterfall that allows you to ease your way into learning the ropes. You will soon reach what it's called the "Big Boy", the second largest waterfall. About half-way through your rappel, you'll hear the call to "LET GO!" a few moments later you'll experience your **first guided free fall**! Finally, you will get **the largest Lost Canyon challenge**: an exciting 200 feet waterfall rappel.

At the end of this tour, enjoy a **delicious typical lunch.** 










Private Transportation from Arenal to Monteverde



Home to cool, **misty cloud forests**, and deep **green foliage almost everywhere** you look, there's no mistaking that you've stepped away from everyday life. If **spending time in nature** is at the top of your travel to-do list, then you'll get your **fill of adventure** in this part of Costa Rica's Central Highlands. From **zip-lining** across a canopy to tours of **coffee plantations**, there are **plenty of activities** to keep you moving in the fresh air. Monteverde is translated as "green mountain", and once you've reached the mountaintop, you'll first come upon the quaint town of **Santa Elena**. Though Monteverde proper does not have a town center, it is comprised of a dirt road that leads to the **Cloud Forest Reserve**. Spread out along this walkable road are hotels, cafes, restaurants, galleries, and **excellent views**

A bilingual guide will welcome you and accompany you during the whole trajectory helping you discover the animals and the plants more interesting that habit in **the exuberant cloud forest**. The tour, which is 3 kilometers approximately, consists of a combination of trails and **seven bridges** where you will have the opportunity to explore all the levels of the cloud forest, as well as the habitats of every single one, starting from the ground and **getting to the top of the great trees.** 



#### Coffee, Chocolate & Sugar Cane Tour (Monteverde) / Private Tour, Transportation included

The coffee tour takes participants on a journey through history. You will learn **the importance of coffee** in Costa Rica's past and current economy. You will walk through **the farm and factory** to see how the bean becomes the rich dark liquid that Costa Ricans love.

The famous **chocolate tour** is next. You will smell and taste different types of chocolate as your guide explains the cultural history behind the treat. The guide will also walk you through how the plant goes from seed to **pure ground cocoa**.
