Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel

During the short drive, you will receive a **brief introduction to Costa Rica** and some recommendations for your trip. The guide will explain your itinerary in detail once you are in the hotel.

Costa Rica's capital and the **largest city in the country**, San Jose is considered to be among the most cosmopolitan cities in Latin America. Downtown San Jose is the busiest part of town. A maze of streets and avenues, here you can find most of the city's museums as well as several hotels and plazas. In the center of the city, several attractions can be found, such as the **National Theater**, **the National Museum**, **and the Jade Museum**. Also, several parks like **Plaza de La Cultura and Parque Morazan** are interesting places to visit. In San Jose exist a wide variety for gastronomic, each corner of the city has great restaurants or the famous **Barrio Escalante**, a gastronomic center where high-quality food is offered. But for more local and typical food the central market offers tasty food.

La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers.** Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.

The Arenal Volcano Rainforest and Natural History along with the **breath-taken lava** flow twill take you through lush rainforest along the base of Costa Rica's most famous volcano. Your experienced, bilingual naturalist guide will point out interesting **plants and wildlife** in the vibrant primary and secondary rainforest of the nature reserve that skirts the **Arenal Volcano 1968 Park.** You'll then arrive at the observation point of the Arenal Volcano -- this is the closest you can get to the base of the Arenal Volcano -- and the perfect vantage point to take remarkable photos of the Arenal Volcano. This hike takes about 1.5 to 2 hours.

Then it's time to head to the **Paradise Hot Springs**, perfect for relax in natural thermal water **pools** and **jacuzzis** of different temperatures with focused hydromassage for back, legs, and feet. The Resort also respects a maximum capacity of visitors to provide a **peaceful atmosphere**. There are showers, massages and body treatments service, food and drink, as well as **reclinable beds**, sun umbrellas, and **relaxing music** along the pool areas. All of the necessary elements for a magnificent and relaxing experience. Here you will enjoy a delicious dinner.





Day 4, 18 Nov 23



Hanging Bridges Nature Walk

A professionally bilingual guide will pick you up in your hotel and drive to one of **the best viewpoints of the Arenal Volcano** high atop a hill across the valley from the iconic volcano. Some trails and bridges bring you as close as you could ever hope to get to the birds, flowers, and the lush vegetation of this **primary rainforest**.

The trails are designed for all ability levels and cover a total of about 2 miles. Once you are on walking along, you will be able to admire **the great diversity of flora and fauna** typically found in the tropical rainforest and also have the opportunity to see many different birds and plant species. Walk right into the forest along several stretches of hanging bridges overlooking the tree canopy along easy, safe and beautiful trails with views of the Arenal Volcano.





Horseback Riding to The Fortuna Waterfall.

On this horseback ride to the La Fortuna Waterfall and Replica Indigenous Village, you will see the spectacular Arenal Volcano and dormant Cerro Chato Volcano off in the distance with gorgeous green countryside all around. The horses are sturdy and friendly bred for tourism and are well adapted to the wet, jungle environment of Costa Rica.

This is a slow and easy ride up to the waterfall, so it is perfect for first-time riders, families, or people who really want to soak in the surrounding natural beauty. Throughout your 1-hour **La Fortuna horseback ride through rainforest trails**, your guide will point out wildlife, and you will get to see beautiful views of the green countryside and the breathtaking Arenal volcano.

There are over 300 steps to get to the base of the **La Fortuna Waterfall** along a private trail. The last part of the hike down you will have to go over a few slippery rocks, but the trek is worth it! When you reach the bottom, you'll have an opportunity to take lots of pictures and swim in the cool waters of one of the largest waterfalls in Arenal.

This where you will get to relax and cool off in the river pools if conditions are suitable! When you're ready, take your time as you head back up the trail and staircase to where your horses will be waiting to take you back to the ranch. This is an excellent, well-rounded horseback ride in La Fortuna.

On your way back, you'll stop by a little thatched-roof cabin to learn about **the Maleku**, one of Costa Rica's few remaining indigenous tribes that originates in the Arenal area. You will get to learn a little bit more about the Maleku culture and see the Maleku traditional handicrafts. You may even pick up a few words in Maleku like "kapi kapi!"





Day 5, 19 Nov 23



Arenal Canopy Adventure & Tarzan Swing

Your tour will begin with a warm welcome and a brief safety speech, after which your equipment will be put on and carefully checked by the bilingual guides. Enjoy this **thrilling aerial adventure** of approximately 3 kilometers, starting from a tower 13 meters high and glide your way down **8 cables**, ranging from 80 meters to 750 meters in length, with an average height of 38 meters.

Speeds will top **60 kilometers per hour**! Each of the **14 platforms**, 5 of which are constructed in extraordinary trees, were strategically designed at varying heights to allow the clients to observe **the rainforest** from different angles and photograph the **awe-inspiring scenery**.
