Day 1, 12 Aug 23

Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel

Right after you go through immigration and customs one representative will meet you at **the Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) exit** to load the luggage into the vehicle and transfer you to the hotel. The hotel for tonight is close to **San Jose city**, located 25-15 minutes away from the airport. During the short drive, you will receive a **brief introduction to Costa Rica** and some recommendations for your trip. The guide will explain your itinerary in detail once you are in the hotel.

Costa Rica's capital and the **largest city in the country**, San Jose is considered to be among the most cosmopolitan cities in Latin America. Downtown San Jose is the busiest part of town. A maze of streets and avenues, here you can find most of the city's museums as well as several hotels and plazas.

In the center of the city, several attractions can be found, such as the **National Theater, the National Museum, and the Jade Museum**. Also, several parks like **Plaza de La Cultura and Parque Morazan** are interesting places to visit. In San Jose exist a wide variety for gastronomic, each corner of the city has great restaurants or the famous **Barrio Escalante**, a gastronomic center where high-quality food is offered. But for more local and typical food the central market offers tasty food.

3 Days in Pacuare Lodge

Once you are ready to start the adventure, the expert guides will proceed with the safety talk, technical instructions, and you will have the chance to practice paddling on calm water. From there you will explore the stunning river rapids and enjoy the majestic scenery among you; today you will relish the river for about 1.5 hours until you reach the amazing Lodge immerged in the dense rainforest. A representative will pick you up early today and take you to the area of Siguirres on the Caribbean slopes. On the way, you will enjoy a delicious typical breakfast.

Upon arrival at the lodge, you can have lunch, the afternoon is free to rest on the comfortable suite, explore the hotel private trails or swim on the natural river pools.

IMPORTANT NOTE: For these days, you can carry a bag with your clothes and things you will need. The maximum luggage weight is 25 pounds per person. The rest of your luggage will stay safely in the Lodge's operations center and you will not have access to it.

Day 3, 14 Aug 23

This day you will enjoy the peaceful hotel in the middle of the forest. You can enjoy the facilities of the hotel and become one with nature.

The hotel has different activities included for you. You can get more information about these tours at the hotel. You can choose any of the following tours:

Pacuare Canopy: Most of the action in the rainforest happens not at ground level, but in the treetops. That's why the canopy adventure is perfect for thrill-seekers and nature lovers alike.

Canyoning Tesorito Creek experience: You'll rappel down shorter walls – between 2 and 20 meters (6 to 65 feet) – before undertaking the thrilling rappel down a 30-meter (90-foot) cliff.

Cabecar Indigenous Hike: The Talamanca Mountains are host to the Cabécar indigenous group and one that retains many of its traditional customs and beliefs. The trek to visit these family clans is challenging due to the difficult conditions of the trails; nevertheless, the trail offers a wonderful opportunity to discover many secrets of the forest.

Early Birdwatching walk: Costa Rica is a birder's paradise. Because of our position between North and South America, we receive migrating species from both sides of the continent. Costa Rica is home to some 850 species of birds, of which 630 are residents. There is ample opportunity to see exotic species every time you go out your front door.

Rural experience: Close to the Pacuare Lodge, on the far bank of the river, there is a small village called Bajo del Tigre Together with your naturalist guide, you will explore the river basin and rainforest by foot and visit the community of Bajo del Tigre, a small farming community that produces spices, roots, tubers, and more.

Sustainable tour: Experience a behind- the —scene tour of the hotel facilities. Learn more about the concept, history, and actions that have been taken to minimize impacts on the environment while supporting conservation and providing benefits for nearby communities.

Day 4, 15 Aug 23

Because there is not a better way to get out of this jungle paradise than riding a wild river for 2 hours, surrounded by magnificent scenery and accompanied by the best tour-guides who will make sure you have a lifetime experience in the Tropics.

This is without a doubt the most exciting activity you can do in the rainforest and takes place in one of the most beautiful rivers in the world. White water rafting in the Pacuare River will remind you the first time you ride a bike without help, or the first kiss... here you will forget about everything to focus on nature and enjoyment. Along the ride you will face exhilarating rapids that will keep you alert, some of these are Upper and Lower Huacas, Cimarron, and Dos Montañas. High waterfalls on the river banks make think this place came out from Jurassic Park or other Holywood movie, your mind flies while you paddle river down and try to stay in the raft. One half of the river is conquered, the guides will prepare a picnic lunch on the banks of the river; recharge energy with a delicious meal and enjoy the last part of this water adventure.

La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers.** Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.

These trails bring you as close as you would ever hope to see the rainforest and its inhabitants, as well as give you access to see **stunning views of the rainforest and mountains**.

After your adventure on the hanging bridges, you will head to the **Arenal Volcano National Park**. The trails are generally flat and not very strenuous, perfect for a **leisurely and informative guided walk**. Enjoy a delicious **lunch** at this point.

Then, you will finish the day at the stunning **La Fortuna Waterfall**. When you reach the entrance, you will have time to change into your bathing suit in case you want to cool off in the **cool pools that flow from the waterfall**. This is sure to be a good workout as there are 500 steps to get to the down to the waterfall, and 300 to get back up! When you reach the bottom, you'll have an opportunity to take lots of pictures and **swim in the cool waters** of one of the largest and most breathtaking waterfalls in Arenal!
