DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1, 23 Dec 24

Private Transfer IN from Airport to Hotel in SJO

Right after you go through immigration and customs one representative will meet you at **the Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) exit** to load the luggage into the vehicle and transfer you to the hotel. The hotel for tonight is close to **San Jose city**, located 25-15 minutes away from the airport. During the short drive, you will receive a **brief introduction to Costa Rica** and some recommendations for your trip. The guide will explain your itinerary in detail once you are in the hotel.

Costa Rica's capital and the **largest city in the country**, San Jose is considered to be among the most cosmopolitan cities in Latin America. Downtown San Jose is the busiest part of town. A maze of streets and avenues, here you can find most of the city's museums as well as several hotels and plazas.

In the center of the city, several attractions can be found, such as the **National Theater, the National Museum, and the Jade Museum**. Also, several parks like **Plaza de La Cultura and Parque Morazan** are interesting places to visit. In San Jose exist a wide variety for gastronomic, each corner of the city has great restaurants or the famous **Barrio Escalante**, a gastronomic center where high-quality food is offered. But for more local and typical food the central market offers tasty food.

Tortuguero is located in the north Caribbean of Costa Rica. Tortuguero is one of the most remote places in Costa Rica and is only accessible by boat or plane.

This little village with strong **Afro-Caribbean roots** is best known for attracting hordes of sea turtles such as **Leatherback**, **Loggerhead**, **and Hawksbill turtles**. While peak turtle season is in July and August, the park and village have begun to attract travelers year-round. Tortuguero is great for families and adventure travelers to go on **jungle hikes**, do a **boat tour** in the canals of the National Park, or just relax at the lodge. The Canals of Tortuguero are known as Costa Rica's Amazon-like rainforest there are more of **800 species of wildlife**, especially many types of birds.

The best natural expedition awaits you today. Your expert guide will meet you early at the hotel. You will start traveling northeast to the Caribbean lowlands. You will stop for breakfast at a local restaurant in Guapiles town. After breakfast, you will continue to La Pavona dock, there you will board the special boat that will take you to the lodge immersed in the jungle.

This afternoon, you will have a **guided tour to the Village of Tortuguero** and walk around the town to learn about the relaxed way of life in the Caribbean. Your guide will explain to you how this village developed and why they changed their minds about **turtle conservation**.

Lunch and dinner are included at the hotel.





Day 3, 25 Dec 24

This morning, after breakfast, you have a **boat tour on the Tortuguero National Park** with the company of a local expert nature guide. The small boats go deep into the canals of the national park, further beyond where other boats can go. Due to the ability to explore further into the canals, you will have the opportunity to find rarer species of wildlife.

NOTE: The entrance fee to Tortuguero National Park is not included. It is \$15 USD per person.

This afternoon, your guide will take you to a private nature trail where you have an exploring **guided walk inside the jungle**. The walk is relaxed and slow pace as this is a flat trail. The rest of the day is at your leisure; you can relax at the **swimming pool**, take a cocktail admiring the river lagoon or spend the afternoon on the beach.

Lunch and dinner are included at the hotel.

Today after breakfast, the guide will meet you at the main dock of the hotel to return by boat to Pavona's dock; from there continue with land transportation to Guapiles town where you will have another **delicious Caribbean lunch**. After the meal, a representative will pick you up to take you to the next destination of this journey

In the area, you can find the Cahuita National Park and the **Gandoca Manzanillo Wildlife Refuge** both places are ideal to admire the wildlife and the beautiful beaches.

La Fortuna is home to the greater Arenal recreation area, the entire region is paradise on Earth for **outdoor adventurers.** Volcanic views grace the landscape and heat several **geothermal hot springs**. A lake and rivers beckon you toward **aquatic adventure**. Refreshing **waterfalls** reward you after **hikes**, offering crisp pools and spectacular views.

Arenal Volcano is one of **Costa Rica's most notable natural features**. Standing at 5,437 feet (1,657 meters), this volcano has been resting (i.e. not active) since 2010. However, it is no less majestic to behold, as it's practically a behemoth against the region's perfect skies. **Rising above the rainforest** that surrounds its base, Arenal Volcano frames the skyline with near-perfect **symmetry**.

Arenal Volcano Walking Tour

The trails in **Arenal National Park** and other nearby **Arenal Reserves** are generally flat and not very strenuous, perfect for a leisurely and informative guided walk with a professional nature guide. You will hike through well-groomed, **easy trails** that skirt the base of the Arenal Volcano and Lake Arenal Area. This part of the Arenal Volcano had sections that were devastated by **the lava flow of 1968**, so some areas have very little vegetation.

This guided walk provides **perfect photo opportunities** and **magnificent views** of the impressive Arenal Volcano, the pristine Lake Arenal and the extinct volcano Cerro Chato. There are parts of each trail that has forested areas where your nature guide will try to spot **birds**, **monkeys and other animals** in their natural habitat.

Whitewater Rafting at Balsa River, Class 2-3 / Lunch included

Whitewater rafting at Balsa River is great to add to your whitewater rafting vacation and is the perfect rafting tour for **first-timers**, **nature lovers**, **outdoor enthusiasts**, and people who are simply looking for **a fun rafting adventure**! It is known as one of the top family rafting trips in Costa Rica as it is a beautiful river for **families with children**.

The professional rafting guide will get you ready to challenge yourself as you paddle down **10 kilometers of fun, rolling rapids**! You will combine exciting rapids with the chance to admire lush greenery, exotic birds, and animals as you descend this beautiful **class 2-3 river**.

Enjoy a traditional Costa Rican lunch at the end of this tour.

Sloth Tour

The sweet smiling face of the **Costa Rican sloth** is rapidly becoming the iconic symbol of the country's amazing **rainforest wildlife**. All set, you will walk for about 1.2 kilometers through the beautiful rainforest looking for our lazy friend, the sloth.

You will be searching out both **2-toed** and **3-toed sloths**. Although similar, they have distinct differences. The 2-toed Sloth, being nocturnal, can be found sleeping high up in the treetops. More active during daytime hours, the 3-toed Sloth slowly moves through the branches eating leaves, often with a young sloth hugging on for the ride.

And as a bonus, you will also get great views of a variety of birds, brightly-colored toucans, iguanas, and more.



Day 8, 30 Dec 24



Shared Transfer from Arenal to Monteverde, Lake Crossing

The trip combines comfortable **door to door** minivan transfers with a fun and **scenic cruise** across the tranquil **Lake Arenal**, where you will experience beautiful views of **the majestic volcano** and the forested **Tilaran Mountain Range**. You will also have the chance to see a variety of wetland birds such as kingfishers, flycatchers, waders and other exotic species that abound on the lakeshore.

You will be picked up from your hotel in **Arenal** and be driven to the Lake Arenal dam, where you will board a **covered boat**. This is where the scenic 45-minute cruise across the lake begins. Next, you will begin the impressive 1.5-hour journey up the mountainside on a steep road offering stunning views of the lush, green valley. You will be driven directly to your **Monteverde** area hotel.

IMPORTANT: Passengers should expect to carry their bags/luggage to and from the boat. Drivers will do their best to help if you have any problems with carrying heavy bags. Just let them know in advance.

Home to cool, **misty cloud forests**, and deep **green foliage almost everywhere** you look, there's no mistaking that you've stepped away from everyday life. If **spending time in nature** is at the top of your travel to-do list, then you'll get your **fill of adventure** in this part of Costa Rica's Central Highlands. From **zip-lining** across a canopy to tours of **coffee plantations**, there are **plenty of activities** to keep you moving in the fresh air. Monteverde is translated as "green mountain", and once you've reached the mountaintop, you'll first come upon the quaint town of **Santa Elena**. Here you'll find gift stores, accommodations, a bus stop, restaurants, cafes, a supermarket, banks and much more. Though Monteverde proper does not have a town center, it is comprised of a dirt road that leads to the **Cloud Forest Reserve**. Spread out along this walkable road are hotels, cafes, restaurants, galleries, and **excellent views**

Day 9, 31 Dec 24



Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve, Guided Walking Tour

The **Monteverde Cloud Forest Reserve** is the **largest** of these private **protected areas**, with over 25,730 acres (10,415 hectares) of land. More than 500 species of **orchids** cling to the limbs of enormous **trees**, while **vines**, **ferns**, **mosses** and **lichens** fill every other available space.

The Cloud Forest of Monteverde house more than 130 species of **mammals**, 400 species of **birds**, including the beautiful **quetzal**, 30 species of **hummingbirds**, 5000 species of **moths** and 3000 species of **plants**.

It is a **nature lover's paradise**.

Canopy Tour (Zip Line)

The tour is located in a private reserve created in 1994. It starts with a short guided walk through the private 70-acre reserve of the **cloud forest**. The first part of the tour will take you through primary (old growth), and secondary (new growth) forest. You will **fly through the treetops** listening closely to the vast variety of birds that can be seen throughout the reserve. Then, just when you think you have become one with the canopy the tour ends with an exhilarating **rappel down** from the "Scary Tree". The tour has **10 cables**, **1 rappel**, **1 Tarzan swing and Holow tree climbing**.







Day 10, 01 Jan 25



Transfer to Manuel Antonio Beach with Tarcoles Safari Boat / Lunch included

This morning, you'll have a transfer to the Manuel Antonio area. On the way, you will have a **safari boat tour at Tarcoles River**. This is a great way to break up the long, 5-hour drive from **Monteverde to Manuel Antonio Beach** because you are bound to see a **multitude of wildlife** including the famous, huge, **20-ft American crocodiles** that inhabit the Carara Biological Reserve area of the Tarcoles River.

Keep your eyes peeled for a rare sighting of the **Scarlet Macaw** and over fifty other species of birds you can see there. Your guide will point out the often difficult-to-see wildlife along this **two-hour boat tour** of the Tarcoles River and into the **Guacalillo Mangrove Estuary**. A delicious lunch is included at the end of the boar tour.

From there you will continue your way to the amazing Manuel Antonio area.

At your convenience and leisure, you can stop and enjoy some local fresh fruits and refreshments as you pause to soak in the beautiful aesthetics. Enjoy some leisure time to **swim** at the pristine water of **the virgin beaches** inside of the national park, consider **the most beautiful beaches** of Costa Rica.
