Mini Combo La Fortuna Waterfall Guided Hike and Volcano Walk

First you will start the day at the stunning **La Fortuna Waterfall**. When you reach the entrance, you will have time to change into your bathing suit in case you want to cool off in the **cool pools that flow from the waterfall**. This is sure to be a good workout as there are 500 steps to get to the down to the waterfall, and 300 to get back up! When you reach the bottom, you'll have an opportunity to take lots of pictures and **swim in the cool waters** of one of the largest and most breathtaking waterfalls in Arenal!

Then You will head to the **Arenal Volcano National Park**. The trails are generally flat and not very strenuous, perfect for a **leisurely and informative guided walk**. Enjoy a delicious **lunch** at this point.

Day 3, 29 Mar 24



Rio Celeste National Park, Guided Hike

The Rio Celeste Waterfall is near the Tenorio and Miravalles Volcanoes. Once you get here, you will begin a **hike through the dense**, **lush**, **tropical rainforest** that surrounds the Tenorio National Park. You can go at your own pace and you will learn interesting things about the rainforest along the way. This hike takes about 1.5 to 2 hours or about 6 kilometers long (3 miles) and is considered a **moderate hike**.

When you arrive at "Los Teñideros", where two rivers come together, you will be amazed at **the celestial turquoise blue watercolor** that comes from the waterfall. This color is created when the minerals in the water (aluminum, silicon, and oxygen) are suspended in the water and refracts light from the sun so that the flow looks blue. Get your camera ready because this is **the perfect place to take photos** of this unforgettable **Costa Rica blue waterfall**!

At the end of this hike, you will enjoy a **delicious lunch**.





Day 4, 30 Mar 24



Birdwatching by The Lake

The elusive **tropical birds** of Costa Rica are best spotted in the wee hours of the morning or also close to sunset. Your nature guide will take you on a walk, providing interesting facts about Costa Rica nature and the different birds that live here.

You will see a **wide array of exotic birds** from toucans, parrots, Montezuma Oropendolas, colorful tanagers, and parakeets. If you are a more serious birdwatcher, your guide will use his eagle-eyes to spot **the harder to see birds** such as Royal Flycatchers, White-fronted Nunbirds, Cinnamon Woodpeckers and other bird species in Costa Rica.





Day 5, 31 Mar 24



Caño Negro Safari Boat Tour / Lunch included

On this **nature and wildlife boat tour**, you'll take a peaceful ride in a **covered motorboat** along Rio Frio to appreciate the beautiful flora and fauna of one of the most biologically diverse areas in Costa Rica and the world! Additionally, this tour includes a **delicious lunch**.

The **Caño Negro Wildlife Refuge** encompasses an area of about 10,000 hectares near the border with Nicaragua. The wildlife in this area is truly spectacular, especially the birds! It is one of the few places in Costa Rica where you can catch a glimpse of the exotic **Jabiru Stork**, the tallest flying bird found in Central and South America. You will get the opportunity to likely see **wood storks**, **cormorants**, and other varieties of birds; this is a must-do tour for avid birdwatchers! Plus, everyone loves to spot the **sloths**, **howler monkeys**, **and caimans** that inhabit this lush area.

Your passport or a copy of your passport and Costa Rica entrance stamp is required for the tour.
